Mayor Fiorentini called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

1. Approval of Meeting Minutes from June 16, 2015 SBC Meeting:

MOTION: made by Mr. DiBurro and seconded by Mr. Goldfield and approved unanimously, to approve the June 16, 2015 SBC meeting minutes; the motion was approved unanimously.

2. Construction Documents and Schedule Update

William Cunniff from Joslin Lesser + Associates (JLA) summarized the progress made since the June 16, 2015 SBC meeting, stating that the steel erection has started. Concrete foundations in Area A are complete with Area B & C proceeding on schedule. The waterline and drainage construction has started for the driveway, with the utility feeds being targeted for completion before winter weather. Temporary power for construction is been delayed, due to National Grid not having placed temp power poles on the project site. City will work to see what they can do from their end. Shawmut Construction & Design (SDC) will forward Orlando Pacheco the National Grid contract for reference. Access road bituminous binder course and walkway were reported to be on track for completion before start of school in September.

There was also a point of interest brought up by the Mayor concerning the use of local workforce on the project. He referenced a local ordinance stating that the project should employ 30% Haverhill residence. JLA will look into this possibility and will report back. (Note: Bill Cox reported back to JLA on 7/22 that the ordinance had been repealed.)

It was noted that the project is not requiring CORI checks for the construction workers. School administration people have/ will continue to accompany visitors/trade personnel that may want to review existing conditions in the Hunking School.

3. GMP Amendment #2 Approval

JLA presented the GMP Amendment #2 for \$37,256,894.00 to SBC for approval. Added to interim GMP Amendment #1 for \$12,387,876, it brings the total GMP Contract Value to \$49,544,770, which is below the MSBA approved construction budget of \$49,998,830.

MOTION: made by Mr. Pacheco and seconded by Mr. Goldfield and approved unanimously, to authorize the GMP Amendment #2 for SDC.
