PAY WITH YOUR CROSBY FLEX DEBIT CARD

Pay for eligible orthodontia expenses with your Crosby Flex Debit Card associated with your Healthcare FSA. You'll love the swipe-and-go convenience of this preloaded debit card.

Be sure to save the detailed receipt and payment contract provided by your orthodontist. The IRS requires you to verify your card transactions.

PAY YOUR ORTHODONTIST DIRECTLY

Pay your orthodontist directly from your Healthcare FSA and submit your reimbursement request online at mycrosbybenefits.com.

You'll need to submit a copy of your orthodontia service contract through your Crosby account when you file a reimbursement request. Please make sure your contract includes the following: 1) provider name, 2) patient name, 3) description of service, 4) payment schedule (including dates of service), and payment amount.
