Middle School World Language Program Application

2017-2018 School Year

The Haverhill Public Schools will continue its middle school language program for students who will be in the 8th grade next year. This program involves students taking a full year course at the Haverhill High School, Monday through Friday, either German, Italian, Latin or Spanish. The following are details about the program:

- Students in the 8th grade will take a chosen language class each day with other high school students.
- Students successfully completing the full-year class will receive 1 high school credit upon enrollment at Haverhill High School. Students may enroll in the second year of their chosen language in the 9th grade at either the College Prep or Honors level.
- Students will take the class from 7:26am to 8:10am each school day.
- Students will be responsible for getting to the high school each morning by utilizing the high school yellow buses or parent/guardian/sibling drop-off.
- Students will be transported by school bus from the high school to their respective middle school after class ends to begin their regular school day.
- Deadline for return of application is **Friday**, **June 16th.** Please return to the main office of your student's current middle school or to the school department in City Hall.
- Acceptance to program is not guaranteed. First choice of language is based on availability.
- Priority will be given to students currently attending a Haverhill Public Middle School.
