Recommended Session Lengths for the 2017-2018 MCAS High School Tests

Note that test sessions for high school students will remain untimed for 2017–2018. Changes to testing time for high school tests will be considered when next-generation high school tests are developed.

The high school *Principal's Administration Manuals* will contain additional information and protocols, but to assist schools when establishing schedules, the following information will be relevant.

The high school tests have prescribed test administration dates in order to maintain the security of these tests. Schools are expected to adhere to these dates. Principals should <u>email the Department</u> if there are extraordinary circumstances.

The June high school STE sessions must be administered on the dates specified below, but it is not necessary to schedule concurrent sessions for the different subject areas (e.g., the Biology test and the Chemistry test may begin at different times).

The tables below show recommended testing times, in minutes, for the 2017–2018 high school MCAS tests and retests.
