Documents listed below are required and must be brought to your appointment.

Child's birth certificate

Child's health records

Immunizations up-to-date

Results of lead testing done after nine months old - Pre-K/Kindergarten only

Physical exam dated within one year

TB test or "Low Risk" results

Vision screening - Pre-K/Kindergarten only

Last report card or transcript, if transferring from another school district

IEP if student receives services under a Special Education program

504 plan if student receives services under Section 504

Proof of residency: All applicants for enrollment must submit one document from each column below:
