Reports:

Student Advisory Council Report.

Devin Tatro, secretary of the Student Council, presented the Student Advisory Council report.

<u>Budget Breakdown – Mr. Magliocchetti.</u>

Mr. Magliocchetti requested a budget breakdown by city funds, state funds, federal funds, and other funds which total 100 percent of the budget. The Superintendent detailed how the budget is funded: 48.7 percent comes from the state, 47.99 percent from the city, 2.78 percent from the federal and .045 percent from other. Members discussed the budget allocations and future funding. Mr. Bevilacqua requested a three to five year report for the next meeting in respect to past grant receipts to help forecast for the upcoming budget.

<u>Report from the Superintendent on Improvement of District Student Achievement – Requested by Mr.</u> Magliocchetti.

Mr. Magliocchetti asked for a brief report on what each principal believes will have the greatest impact on improving student achievement in his/her school and requested that principals be in attendance. The Superintendent noted the top five recommendations to improve student achievement: smaller class sizes; sustained district funding of professional development and collaboration; instructional materials and supplies; sufficient professional support staff for all programs and in all schools; and a quality learning environment. Principals commented on the five listed areas. The committee asked what principals would sacrifice to attain these goals in the next budget. Principals offered suggestions on creative ways to look strategically at the budget and to make better use of diminishing funds.

Report from the Superintendent on District Class Sizes – Dr. Buchanan (requested by Mr. Magliocchetti).

Mr. Magliocchetti requested a report on class sizes throughout the district and the administration's plans to reduce class sizes throughout the district. The Superintendent reviewed enrollment figures to date. Mr. Nangle, HHS Principal, reviewed the high school numbers over 714 academic sections. The Superintendent delineated the creative ways to address the issues, different configurations, providing adequate services to students that need special attention, and the ability to reorganize the district.

Status Report on Athletic Program at Haverhill High School Prepared by Garin Veris (requested by Mr. Magliocchetti).

Mr. Magliocchetti asked for an update on the state of the athletic program at the high school and a report from the Superintendent on future plans to coordinate a district wide middle school and high school athletic program. Mr. Veris was unable to attend tonight and asked Mrs. Danehy, Athletic Subcommittee Chairperson to read his updated report and the minutes of the last meeting. Mr. Veris will make a PowerPoint presentation at the first meeting in February. Mr. Magliocchetti requested to include a one, three, and five year plan.

Superintendent's Plan for Viable District Band Program – Dr. Buchanan (requested by Mr. Magliocchetti).

The Superintendent indicated in a recent survey a total of 42 students have expressed interest in receiving music lessons. The next approach is to meet with the music teachers to begin immediately. Drs. Buchanan and O'Brien will meet with the music instructors to discuss the program, instruments, and possibly reorganizing the teaching staff with dual certifications to provide this service. The restoration of this program through a planned approach was requested by members.

Dr. Buchanan presented his Hillie Highlights' Report.

The Superintendent discussed recent donations for the textbook project receiving over \$110,000 the past three years and indicated an approximate balance of \$75,000. Members questioned the balance when there is a need for textbooks; the payment/bonding; and what books are needed.
