1.0 SCOPE OF SERVICES

1.1 Abatement Project Monitoring

- (a) CDW will conduct daily project monitoring during asbestos abatement, to observe the quantities, locations, and types of asbestos-containing materials (ACM) removed in accordance with the construction specifications related to ACM and hazardous materials removal. CDW's labor cost for monitoring the abatement work is based on the presence of one person for each of forty (40) 8-hour work shifts during typical first shift hours (7am-4pm Mon-Fri). The actual number of shifts will depend upon the Contractor's abatement schedule, labor force, etc.
- (b) CDW will provide daily air sampling to ensure the contractor's abatement methods are appropriate, and that the contractor's activities are coordinated with the construction manager for efficient abatement work.
- (c) CDW will prepare daily field notes which will include the amounts and types of ACM abated. CDW's notes will be compared daily with contractor's removal quantities to ensure that quantities are reconciled appropriately.



1.2 Project Management during Construction

(a) CDW's Project Manager will visit the Site periodically and will attend up to four meetings as requested. An allowance has been established for the expected level of effort for this task.

1.3 Abatement Report

- (a) CDW will prepare air clearance letters during construction. Up to 10 air clearance letter reports are included herein.
- (b) CDW will prepare a final summary ACM abatement summary report at the completion of the project. The report will include the final total quantities removed and the air sampling analytical results.


2.0 SCHEDULE OF SERVICES
