Superintendent Marotta presented the subcommittee with an updated Homeless Policy [Updated Homeless Policy 02.05.19.pdf](#) that MASC recommended be revised and approved.

The subcommittee discussed the Superintendent’s Goals (01.10.19) and how they aligned with the School Committee goals:

The superintendent shall:

- 1) achieve a five percent reduction in the number of students who are chronically absent.
- 2) meet with all principals and provide them with written evaluations pursuant to pertinent state guidelines.
- 3) implement at least two of the financial management recommendations from the MASBO financial review.
- 4) identify schools that would qualify for the state’s Accelerated Repair Program. Create the necessary statements of interest by the February deadline.
- 5) present a goal based budget to the School Committee.
- 6) analyze and correct flaws in data gathering. The superintendent shall create a plan to more effectively use the data gathered.
- 7) provide school leaders with training about how to improve community engagement.
- 8) look for and apply for grants to expand extended learning time.
- 9) research evidence based programs for improving MCAS scores at the high school. She will share this with the high school administration and encourage them to improve their current efforts.

A motion was made by Ms. Sullivan to adjourn the subcommittee meeting (9:50 a.m.). Attorney Rosa seconded the motion.
