## What We Do

The Salvation Army of Haverhill provides a wide variety of ministries, programs and services to the residents of the communities of the Haverhill, Bradford and Groveland.

- $\checkmark$  The Food Pantry is open Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9:30 a.m. 11 a.m. Residents of Haverhill, Bradford and Groveland are able to come to pantry twice a month. A current ID and proof of address are needed. Produce and Frozen meats available through the Pantry.
- ✓ Sally's Kitchen community feeding program is open Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 12 noon 1 p.m. for lunch. Anyone is welcome to come join us for lunch!
- ✓ Referrals are given to community resources such as Ruth's House, Mission of Deeds, Common Grounds, Community Action, Pregnancy Care Center, Anchor of Hope, etc.
- ✓ The Good Neighbor Energy Fund provides utility assistance to qualifying families who do not qualify for any government assistance (SNAP, TANF, Section 8) usually January to April. December for those with a shut off.
- $\checkmark$  When FEMA/EFSP monies are available, we can assist with back payments on rent or mortgage for up to one month per household.
- ✓ Bridging the Gap program is aimed to empower our youth with the skills they need to be successful adults. BTG is designed for youths 12-17, who desire to enhance their character through Leadership Development, Community Involvement, Peer Support and more!
- ✓ Our Christmas Assistance program provides Christmas gifts to children 12 and under in Haverhill, Bradford and Groveland.
- $\checkmark$  For Thanksgiving, we serve a special Thanksgiving Luncheon on the Wednesday before Thanksgiving.
- ✓ We have a variety of ministries for youth and adults including Bible Studies, Women's
  Ministries, Sunday School, Worship Services, Family Activities, Music Lessons, Salvation Army
  Troops programs and Special Events.
- ✓ Camps and Retreats for youth and adults include: Camp Wonderland Youth Camp, Women's Retreat, Teen Camp, Men's Camp, Older Adult Ministries camp, A Weekend with Mommy Camp, Family Camps and Teen & Young Adult Retreat.
- ✓ Volunteer Opportunities are available in many different areas including: Kitchen Assistant, Food Pantry Helper, Backpack 68 Assistant, Maintenance and Janitorial, Special Events, Truck Loading/Unloading and of course, Bell Ringing!!!
