Discussion

Hub Testing Laboratory was requested to verify the presence of asbestos in the stored laboratory table tops located in classroom 42 of the Consentino School. Two sizes of laboratory table tops were identified; one that was approximately 8 feet long by 3 feet wide and 16 that were approximately 10 feet long and 2 feet wide. The laboratory table tops were stored in groups of four along the front, back and right side of the classroom. The larger laboratory table top was resting on the group of four at the back of the classroom. The inspector examined each laboratory table top and determined them to be one homogenous material. A total of four samples were collected; three samples from the smaller laboratory table tops and one sample of the larger laboratory table top. These samples were returned to the laboratory and analyzed for the presence of asbestos.

Analysis:

Analysis for the presence of asbestos was performed using Polarized Light

Microscopy EPA/600/R-93/116, July 1993.
