This application form must be completed and submitted to the Haverhill High School CTE Program by February 16, 2024. In addition to this application form, the applicant's guidance counselor will submit academic, attendance and discipline records to be used as a basis for admission. For fall admission, this would be term 1 of the current school year and terms 1-3 of the previous school year. In addition to grades, attendance and discipline/conduct, the guidance counselor's recommendation will be used. A fifth criteria consisting of an interview with the applicant will also be used.

The application process is:

- 1. Fill out and return the application by February 16th 2024.
- 2. Request (a) academic, attendance and discipline records and (b) a guidance counselor recommendation.
- 3. A representative from Haverhill High School will contact you to schedule a personal interview.
- 4. Admission decisions will be sent out according to the date specified on the Haverhill High School calendar.
