Pre-AP courses are designed in partnership with college faculty and the College Board to ensure foundation for college and career readiness



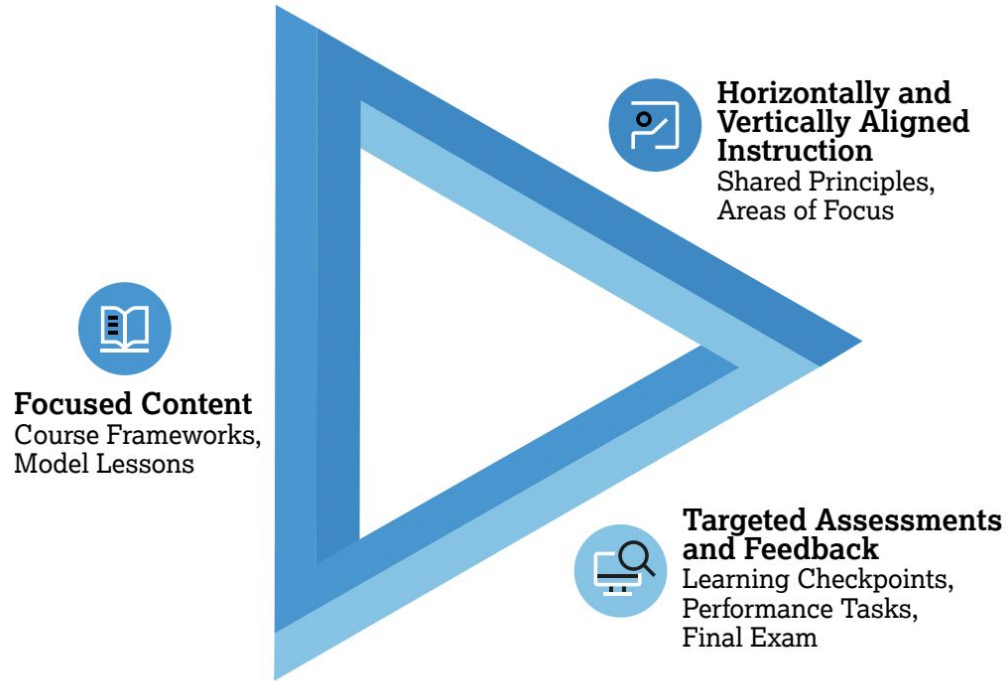
Why Pre-AP

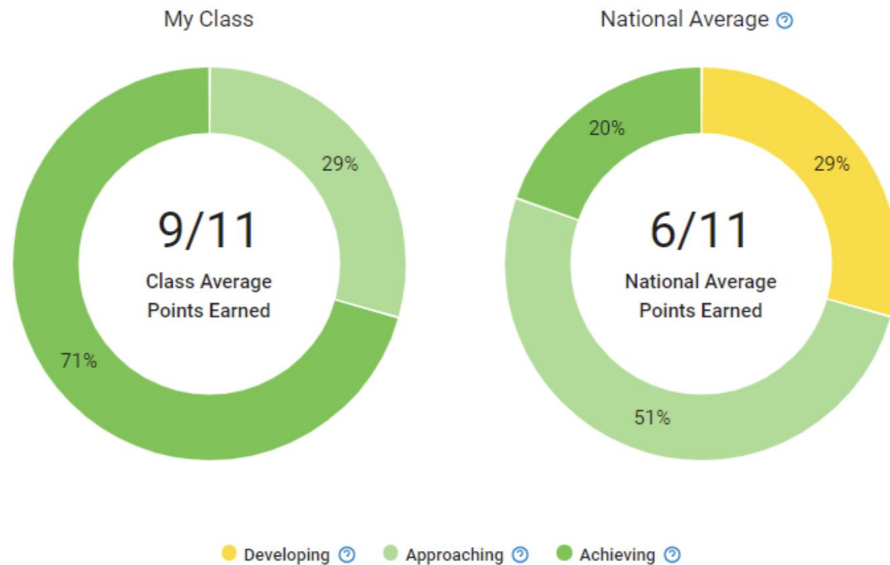

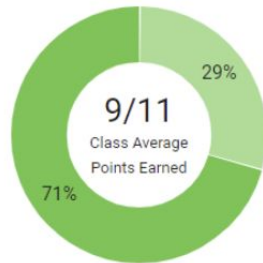

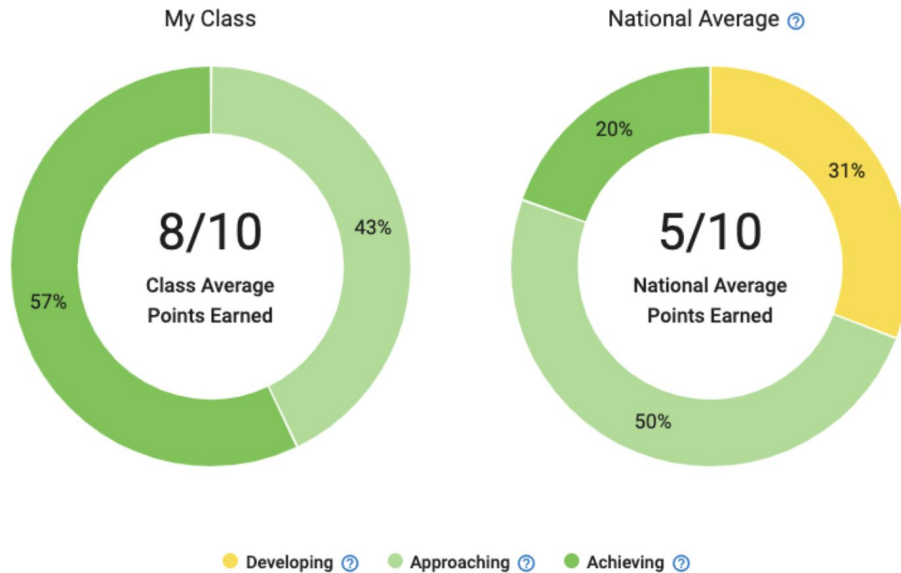
