
Why is it dangerous to experiment with any kind of drug?

People can't tell how they'll react to a drug before they use it.

- A drug can hurt a person the first time they use it.
- Experimenting with any drug can lead to addiction.
- You can't know who will become addicted and who won't.

What is vaping?


- Inhaling and exhaling the aerosol (often called vapor) produced by an e-cigarette or similar battery-powered device
- Called e-cigs, vape pens, e-hookahs, e-pipes, tanks, mods, vapes, electronic nicotine delivery systems, or ENDS, and more
- Sometimes referred to by brand names such as JUUL (Juuling), BO, Blue, and others






E-cigarettes Make Aerosol, Not Vapor

THE E-CIGARETTE AEROSOL THAT USERS BREATHE FROM THE DEVICE AND EXHALE CAN CONTAIN HARMFUL AND POTENTIALLY HARMFUL SUBSTANCES:




vaped?



- Yes!
- Open systems require the user to add the e-juice,
 which can be a substance other than nicotine.
- Closed systems (those that use pre-filled pods) can also be altered to vape substances other than nicotine GET (III)


